Install Instructions

NOTES: Please check for any damage caused by the shipping company, take a full set of hi res photos, and take appropriate steps to file a claim, if needed. Start with notifying the NPC

*Please call **Digsafe** and check for any underground utilities before digging anywhere.

Materials needed

None, unless you desire a fall/use zone.

Instructions

1. Check with your local playground safety codes for use zone requirements.
2. Depending on the size of your Fallen Tree, it may be very heavy. Your first challenge is getting it out of the box truck or off the trailer it's shipped in/on, so plan on unloading and moving it accordingly — with many strong people, or with a piece of machinery, preferably one with forks. You may need heavy chain or rope to drag it out of the truck.
3. Move the Fallen Tree to desired location, rotate and place so that it sits flat on the ground and does not shift positions. When choosing a location consider, certain openings could present an entrapment hazard if the distance between any opposing surfaces is greater than 3.5 inches and less than 9 inches, unless the bottom side of the opening is woodchips.
4. If you are “fixing” this to the ground with anchors, and need to install footings for those anchors, mark the locations where the trunk and branches touch the ground, move the Fallen Tree to one side so you can dig the holes and pour the footings (the tops of which **MUST** be below the fall zone material), then move the Fallen Tree back into position.
5. Conduct frequent inspections to help prevent injuries caused by splintered wood, sharp points, corners, or edges that may develop as a result of wear and tear on the fallen tree.
